2.	Read 1 Corinthians 6:18–20 & Proverbs 7:6-27. Why is the proper response to sexual temptation to flee from it rather than to 'stand your ground?'
	a. What is something specific in your life (certain music, movies/shows, social media apps, restaurants, stores, etc.) that you must avoid because it tempts you with sexual immorality?
3.	Read 1 Thessalonians 4:3-4 & 1 Corinthians 10:13. How do these passages give you hope that you can defeat any temptation, including strong sexual temptations, that comes your way?
	a. Why is community a critical component in the Holy Spirit's plan to help you defeat sin as a believer?
4.	Read Proverbs 7:1-5 & Matthew 7:24-27. How does following God's instructions keep you away from falling into sin especially sexual immorality? What are the consequences of disregarding to follow God's Word?
