1.	Read Acts 17:24–29 . Along with Genesis 1 how do these verses show the authority of God over creation and prove a theistic view of God's dealing within creation?
2.	Read Isaiah 6:1–5 . What feeling does this verse evoke in you in regard to God? How should this verse serve to heighten even the highest view of God?
3.	Read Colossians 2:4,8 and Romans 1:18 . What is the danger of allowing others to lessen your view of God? Both for them and for you?
4.	Read John 15:6 and 1 Corinthians 1:18–25 . God has a purpose for humanity. This purpose requires obedience from all of his creation. How do these verses articulate God's purpose for humanity and the consequence of disobedience?
