1. Write down one takeaway or application that encouraged or convicted you from this week's baptism service.

2. If you are a Christian, write down your own testimony using these three categories:

- a. Before Christ: How did you know you were separated from God? See Galatians 5:19-21; 1 Corinthians 6:9-11; and Matthew 15:18-20.

- b. Conversion: When did you turn from your sins and trust in Christ for the forgiveness of your sins? See Acts 26:18; Mark 1:14-15; and Acts 20:18-21.

- c. Life since salvation: How have you witnessed God grow your faith since you were saved? See Galatians 5:22-25; 2 Corinthians 5:17; and Titus 2:11-14.

3. Take time in your LifeGroup for a few people to share their testimony.

4. Read Acts 2:22-41. Can you identify the main elements of the gospel in Peter's sermon? Write down your observations below.

5. Write down how you would share the gospel with an unbeliever. Be prepared to share what you write in LifeGroup this week.
